



Dear Children,

We can't wait to see you all in September and to find out about all of the exciting times you have been having since we last saw you.

I have sent some information to your parents to tell them all about how we have been organising school for your return, so thought I would share some of this information with you too.

Arriving at school

When you arrive at school, your classroom door will be open for you to enter straight away. If you have to wait please use the stars on the playground as they allow you to socially distance from other children and their grown-ups. Unfortunately, your grown-ups will not be able to come into your classroom

In the classroom

In Tulips and Lilies, the desks have all been set out in special rows – so you can all see the front easily. Excitingly, you will also all get your own pencil case of all the equipment you need.

In Roses, Daffodils and Sunflowers, your classroom will be slightly different to you are used to but the adults in there will explain everything to you.

Lilies and Tulips will be in the same classroom as last year however Roses, Daffodils and Sunflowers have moved to ensure you are all comfortable and can have adequate space.

Sunflowers will now be in Daffodils classroom (enter via the playground)

Daffodils will be in Sunflowers classroom (enter via the carpark)

Roses will be in the classroom next to Daffodils (enter via the main entrance).

Please do not worry if you are not sure where to go, we will be there to help you on the first morning of term.

Playtimes and Lunchtimes

At playtime you will be with your teachers and other children from your class.

You will all eat your lunch in the hall in a timetabled slot. The hall will be split into two areas to enable two class bubbles to be in the hall at once. You will need to stay in the hall until most of your bubble has eaten their dinner. You will also have an opportunity to have some of your lunch time outside (inside in inclement weather).

What you can bring to school

Because we have provided all of your equipment, you won't need to bring book bags (we don't have the space for these). You just need to bring a named drinks bottle, (packed lunch in a small box/bag, if this is your choice) and your PE kit in a small bag. Your reading book can be brought in a plastic wallet. Please make sure you remember to bring trainers as all PE will take place outdoors.
