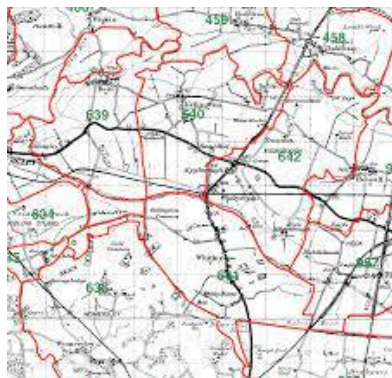
Why do people love their sacred places? What can we learn from visiting holy buildings?
