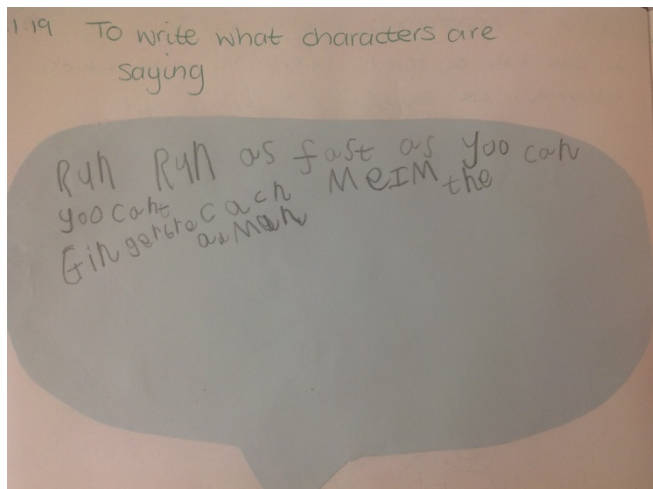

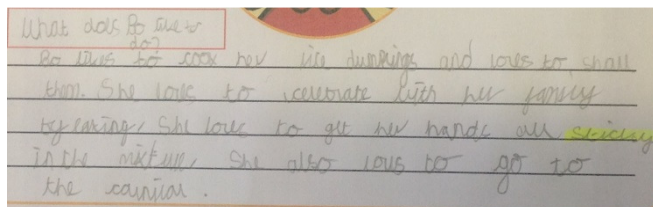

## WEEKLY NEWS

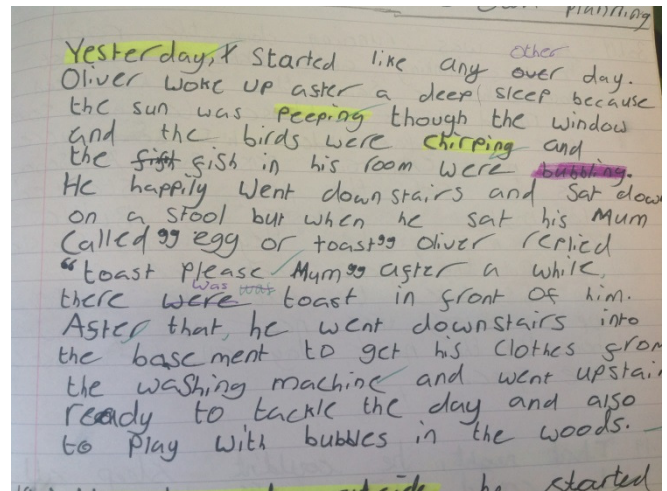

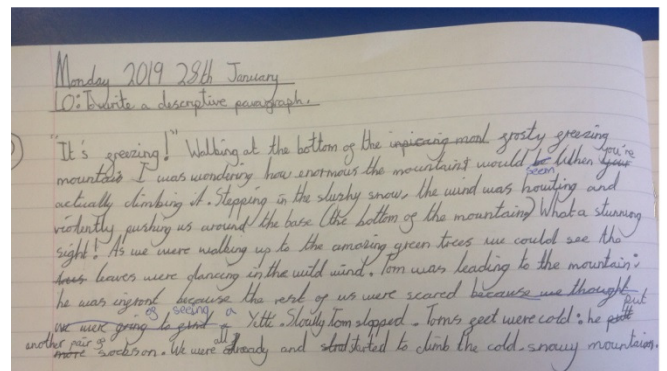
