SCIENCE CLUB



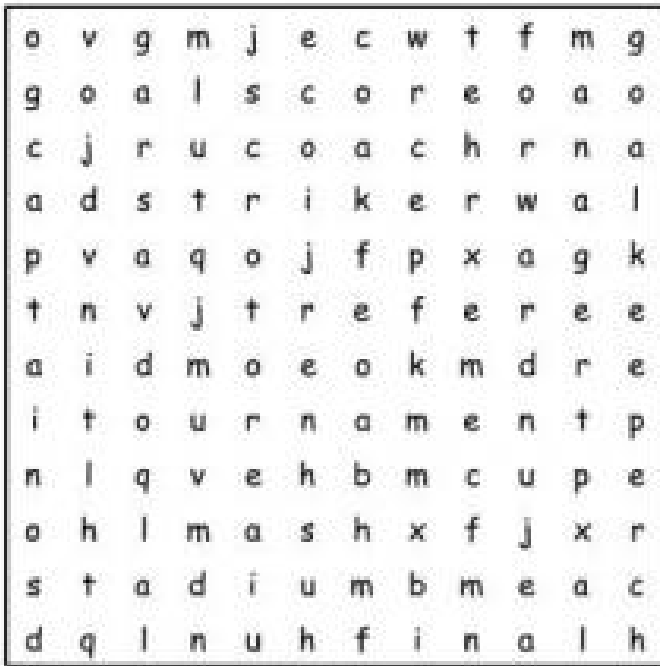
