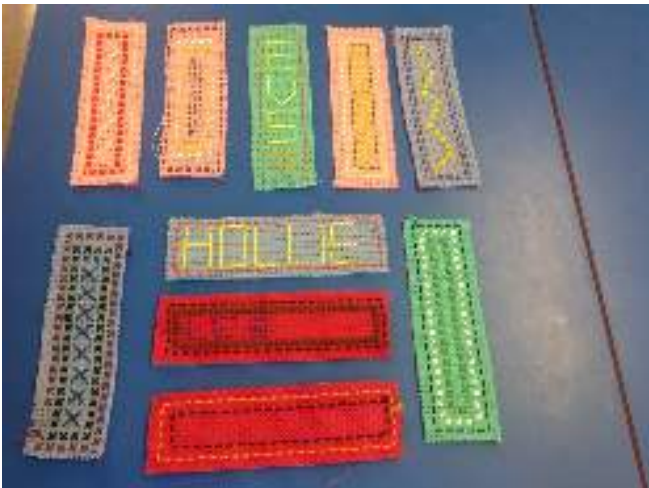
Drax Power Station - Thank you!
