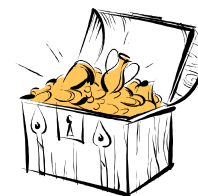

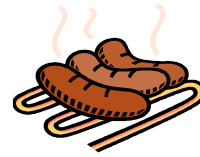
### Bugsy Malone Photos
