**Sapphires - Bottles.**

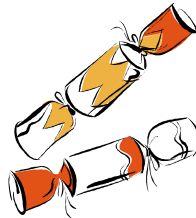


They would also be very grateful for donations of bottle bags. Thank you for your continued support.
