Rocco Charles says "I think Drogon is settling in really well because our class wouldn't be the same without him and I think it was a really good investment for responsibility."

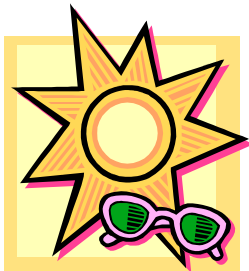
### Outstanding Dinner Money
