Junior Road Safety Competition

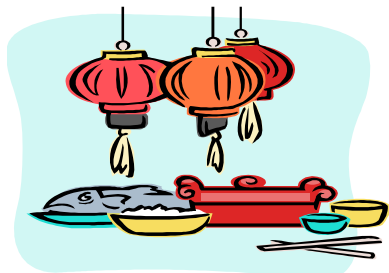
A reminder that the closing date for the colouring competition, which is open to Key stage 1 and 2, is next Tuesday 2nd February.
