Whilst many schools around North Yorkshire are being forced to significantly increase their school meal price due to increased staffing

costs from County Caterers, I am pleased to let you know that the STAR MAT have negotiated a bespoke package for our primaries, such that all primary schools in the MAT can charge the same next academic year. The price will be £2.30 per day, £11.50 per week, for all children in years 3 - 6. Whilst this is a slight increase, we have worked hard to minimise this and we do still feel that it represents superb value for what we offer.
