Our next stay and play will be on Wednesday 14th May at 2.15pm.






The children had a wonderful day in beautiful spring weather.

Action required before the end of March 2025

We have been requested by North Yorkshire Council to ask that if you feel you could be eligible for free school meals to make an application before the end of March. This includes children in Reception, Year One and Year Two.

This is to ensure you claim and future funding is protected. Only applications processed before 1 April 2025 will maintain transitional
