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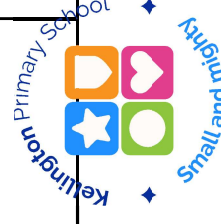
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Accessibility Plan Autumn 2023-2026

A) Improving Curriculum Access

Target	Action Needed	Leadership	Timescale	Outcome
Staff members know whether their curriculum areas are accessible.	Audit of curriculum to ensure each area is matched well to SEND provision.	Head teacher/Teachers	Autumn Term 2023 ongoing	Teams are aware of the accessibility gaps in provision and adapt lessons accordingly.
Enhance staff skills to support pupils with SEND.	Planning of curriculum learning journeys start with provision for SEND pupils and build from there. 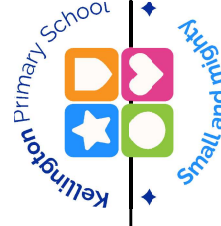
